1. Call to Order-Pledge of Allegiance

Commissioner Kee called the meeting to order at 3pm.

2. Appointment to Environmental Approval Committee

Upon recommendation of Mayor Hill, Commissioner Kee nominated Linda Moses for Appointment to the Environmental Approval Committee. The nomination was seconded by Commissioner Lyons. All voted in favor of Linda Moses being appointed to the Environmental Approval Committee.

3. Discussion of the 4th of July Fireworks Parking

Many concerns were raised regarding the heavy traffic and overflow of parking that will be generated during the 4th of July Fireworks display in Rehoboth Beach. Several precautionary measures are already being put in place: All security officers will be working that evening with one stationed at each Henlopen Acres Entrance, parking stickers must be visible on all vehicles parked in Henlopen Acres or fines will be issued for all unauthorized vehicles.

Additional security measures were discussed and will be explored by the town. These include: hiring off duty police officers to patrol town and/or be stationed at the crosswalk over to the beach club, hiring a crossing guard to be stationed at the crosswalk and purchasing flood lights and/or flares to ensure the crosswalk is properly lit for the residents. Final decisions will be made after the Town of Rehoboth announces their final plans.

5. Adjournment

The meeting was adjourned at 3:18pm by Commissioner Richards and was seconded by Commissioner Kee.
