

#### **Traffic Safety Reminder:**

Now that the warm weather has FINALLY arrived, please be cautious on the roads and remember the Acres will be filled with pedestrians and bikers, including children, as well as increased vehicle traffic. Please also come to a full stop at all STOP signs.

#### **Ordinance Spotlight:**

## Chapter 116-Vehicles and Traffic-Article I. Stop Intersections $\S$ 116-3. Full Stop Required.

Except when directed to proceed by a police officer, every driver of a vehicle approaching a stop intersection indicated by a stop sign shall come to full stop at a **marked** "stop" line, but if none, at the point nearest the intersecting roadway where the driver has a view of approaching traffic on the intersecting roadway before entering the intersection. Security has the authority granted by the State of Delaware to issue citations for violations of this ordinance.
