1. Call to Order – Pledge of Allegiance The meeting was called to order 10:01am by Chairman John Scheurer.

2. Approval of Minutes

a. June 25, 2018

A **motion** to approve the minutes from June 25, 2018 was made by Commissioner Gordon Kaiser and seconded by Commissioner Tim Lyons. **Motion** passed unanimously.

3. OLD BUSINESS

a. Comprehensive Plan Update

Mr. Scheurer led a discussion continuing to update the Comprehensive Plan.

Page 3-History

Additional information added to include details of the original Marsh Farm, the years that the property changed hands from Peter Marsh to the Dodd family (Peter Marsh owned if from 1743-1871 and the Dodd family owned it from 1871-1929 when Colonel Corkran purchased it).

Mr. Scheurer would like to do more research on the Marsh family farm and possibly add a map. Update the date to 1929 in second paragraph relating to the purchase of the Peter Marsh house. Pages 4 & 5 No changes

Page 6-Rehoboth Art League

The paragraph addressing Lot 3, Block J was inserted. Mr. Scheurer will further investigate the details of Lot 1 and Lot 2 as it refers to the Rehoboth Art League and a map of the property will also be included in the Plan.

Page 7-Pioneer and Indian Cemetery

An additional sentence was added at the end of the paragraph addressing that the Town may develop the area into a small park after further investigation into its history.

Page 9-Floodplain

Include information concerning the Town's Flood Plain Management Ordinance

Page 10-Endangered Species

A photo of the signs we installed to protect the Key Wildlife Habitat will be included.

Page 11-Tree Canopy

Tree City designation will be added. Will also add an updated tree canopy map.

Page 12-Demographics

Updates will be made to the population projection and growth using the data from the 2016 DE Population Consortium. Data shows Sussex County is the fastest growing county in the State. Commissioner Bob Reed wants to include the number of undeveloped lots left in Town.

Page 13-Redevelopment

Possibly remove the data regarding vacant lot size.

Page 16

Update information to include new fence ordinance

Page 17-Water Supply

Add information about KCI Technologies evaluation of the Town's water system and include their written report with the Plan. Add more detailed description of the type of underground storage tanks mentioned.

Page 18-Stormwater

There are a few grammatical errors to be fixed. DNREC report should also be included.

Page 19-Wastewater

Will add updated information on Rehoboth's ocean outfall.

Solid Waste Disposal

Add any updates on number of trash companies working in Town.

Maintenance of the Marina

Will update to include information provided in the study from AECOM. Will remove sentence referencing a second groin in the first paragraph.

Page 20-Public Safety

Change wording to Town employs patrolmen instead of maintains a security patrol service.

Fire Protection

Fix grammatical errors and add new paragraph on Rehoboth Volunteer Fire Co and Sussex County Emergency Services.

Page 21-Community Services

Update information on nearest hospital-Beebe Medical Center

Recreation

Add additional information on Gordon's Pond and Breakwater Junction Trails.

Page 22-Recreation (cont.)

Add information on bird watching.

Transportation

Add more information on public transportation.

Page 23-Implementation

Overall goals should be put in order of priority Change the language in the last paragraph from "the Town is concerned" to "the Town plays close attention to".

Page 24- Implementation (cont.)

Second sentence replace "the Town suggests" with "the Town recommends"

Recommendations (pages 24-25)

1. Rehoboth Art League-will shorten the paragraph and delete sentences referencing the MOU.

2. Pioneer and Indian Cemetery-Add information about possibly turning it into a park.

3. Air Quality-update information on no idling policy.

4. Tree Canopy-update tree planting progress.

- 7. Marina-Include AECOM findings and using Evelyn Maumeyer as a consultant to obtain permits to dredge the marina.
- 8. Traffic Study-fix typo, correcting the word "summer"

5. NEW BUSINESS

a. Discussion on traffic and speed limits.

There is a concern by the Mayor and the Commissioners about cars speeding through town with the increased number of pedestrians and bikers during the summer months. Mayor Reich suggests lowering the speed limit to 20 MPH. Mr. Scheurer would like to review what other towns do and discuss again at a future meeting.
