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2025 Election

The 2025 election for the Board of Commissioners will take place on **Saturday, August 30**, from **9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.** at **Town Hall**. The 3-year term of office for Commissioners Jeffrey Jacobs and Richard Thompson is expiring.

Both residents and property owners are eligible to file for candidacy and vote in the election. At least **one resident Commissioner** will be elected in accordance with the Town Charter.

PARKING AND BEACH ACCESS



Summertime means an influx of residents and their guests spending time in Town. Remember:

- Parking on grass or easements in front of homes is permitted for no more than 24 hours.
- Parking on the street is prohibited.
- Permits are required to park in the cul-de-sacs while visiting the beach. Contact Town Hall for resident and visitor parking permits.

2025 Election Frequently Asked Questions

How do I check my voter registration status?

By contacting Town Hall. If you aren't registered, Town staff can provide you with the appropriate forms and help you through the process. **The deadline to register to vote is July 31**.

I will not be in Town on Election Day. Can I vote by absentee ballot?

Yes, absentee ballots will be available by mail or in person pick-up beginning Tuesday, July 15. Completed absentee ballots must be received by 12pm on Election Day.

How do I file as a candidate?

If you'd like to run for Commissioner, you must file a Notice of Intention to Seek Office on or before **4:30 p.m. on Friday, July 11**. Town staff can provide you with the appropriate forms and help you through the process.
